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Human Rights Ahead General Election 2025 in Tanzania: A Comprehensive Study of Local Government Election 2024

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Abstract

This study critically evaluates political rights ahead general election 2025 in Tanzania. The issue of civil liberties has been the focus of attention with the current regime. The posed questions are discussed: Does it mean Tanzania is doing enough to political rights towards a general election of 2025? Has it been more effective in the promotion and protection of human rights of people? Has it capable of inducing the authentic culprits of more stringent assailants of violence and transgressions of the legal system? However, the Tanzania's election system has been accused for contravene with the jus publicum and the rest domestic legal systems. In so far as per current evidence confirm Tanzania is resuming in the dark days of President John Pombe Magufuli when his dissident and human activist were tortured, jailed and executed.

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1. Introduction

It is 63 years since Tanzania gained political independence. One can safely question, what kind of freedom would mean if some the citizens are abducted, tortured, and assassinated for political issues? What does that freedom mean if dissident's arguments are replied by gunfire? What will that independence mean if there is no right to free speech, assembly, and free election? For how long, this situation will proceed on? So, the 64 years of independence is just enjoyed by the minority (the ruling class) not the majority the proletariat class. Such situation remains highly sensitive. In the long run nobody will remain safe or untouched by the current suffering. No more silence Tanzania is bleeding, we are back on those dark days when those dared to push president limits, for instance the opposition leader as well human rights activists such as Tundu Lissu and Ben Saanane among others, faced dire consequence. Lissu barely avoided assassination when his car was sprayed with 36 bullets at a highly secure residential complex in the capital city, Dodoma, in September 2017. Also, according to Kabendera (2024) when Saanane dared for doubting the genuineness of Magufuli's PhD, Saanane was abducted and taken to State House where the president personally shot him in the head. Kabendera continue to narrate in his book "*In the Name of president: Memoirs of a Jailed Journalist*", that Saanane's body was dumped in the river Rufiji. Such incidence is unacceptable according to the human rights framework (1948 concerning first charter that proclaim those thirty rights among other all people are empowered. The civil freedom including natural rights accepted globally as absolute as well authentic on account of individual around the world due to their essence of

being human (Kegley, 2009; Basu, 2009). In fact, civil liberties are primarily the rights that an individual possess since he or she is a human being. Human rights are grounded in the principle of human dignity. We call human rights since they are globally entitled to every individual, regardless who they are. No one can take away your civic freedom. Eleanor Roosevelt, the lady spearheaded the panel that composed this document, declared that human rights framework concedes rights for the benefit of all.

2. Methodology

This study applied new advanced digital research which allowed the researcher to access as well analyze a lot amount of online platforms data, such as, Facebook, Instagram, TikTok, LinkedIn, WhatsApp, X, Reddit, web, community forums, newspapers, journals, books, blogs, articles and cartoon animation. This approach facilitated the sharing of ideas, opinions and thoughts about political sentiments as well human rights engagement in Tanzania as we move closer to the 2025 general election.

3. Findings

3.1. Local Government Election 2024

Election procedures remain the most complicated issue in Tanzania. The main issue on electoral administration is who should facilitate the elections? Electoral authority that are not generally considered impartial can dangerously damage authenticity of the electoral system (Asamoah, 2019). While, Sisk (2008) argues that supportive aspects for instance, comprehensive membership composition, political compromise as well professional competence, in the event of absence activate related bloodshed. Tanzania's local government election 2024 was conducted in grievously constrict political situation. According to Article 21, of the human rights framework (1948) everyone is entitled to engage in public affairs of his or her home country, explicitly or implicitly (Simkhada, 2021). The people's voice will be the core of the state agency, this shall be granted in respect from time to time as well fair ballot to be determined by a referendum or complimentary electoral process.

The popular sovereignty shall determine state authority; such sovereignty shall be repeated as well legitimate elections be by confidential vote. That is what we call the right to democracy. While, Tanzania-local election of 2024 witnessed, thousands of opposition candidates were disqualified by the party in power Chama Cha Mapinduzi (CCM) appeared terrified of losing power to the extent of disqualifying thousands of opposition party especial CHADEMA and ACT-Wazalendo members in local election. Unabashedly, it was mass disqualification so CCM candidates pass unopposed. This indicates that democracy seem to be a taboo to CCM. The local government election was organized and run by the rules and laws of jungle.

Also, the ruling party used children to register in the base of boosting their voter's registry, the children laughed of being the given absurd ages like 30 and above to make it look adults. This was not even funny it was child abuse and breach of data. One of the respondents had this to say:

... the truth is, there's nothing like elections in Tanzania. This shambolic process is a wastage of time! Let them continue with their hooliganism and thuggery.

Tanzania Episcopal Conference (TEC)-technically the council of Catholic bishops issued a strong statement in Tanzania condemning the undemocratic process in local elections. In fact, autocracy needed to be banned to overthrow the legal system (Simkhada, 2021).

3.2. Tanzania's Local Election Day (27/11/2024)

Tanzania's local government elections was marred by allegation of violence and electoral irregularities. There were accounts of violence including fraudulent election dominated to the lowest tier of governance participate in the election in Tanzania. Yet, crossover voter noted trouble with finding their names at voting place as jurisdiction didn't precisely order the names either with regard to sex or graded (The Chanzo Reporter, 2024).

3.2.1. Political Campaign Coordinator

Ushering in the night time of November 26, 2024, the rival parties expressed dissatisfaction with jurisdiction rejecting to give their nominated polling agents credential letter which would assist them to be at the polling area to help their running mate. The problem was brought to attention, primarily impacted CHADEMA and ACT-Wazalendo, pressuring number of them to bow out from the election. At Iringa Urban, for instance, CHADEMA opted to pull out from the election after jurisdiction stopping political campaign coordinator from accessing voting booth. In addition, Chadema bow out in Temeke, offering comparable justification.

ACT-Wazalendo as well complained about the same problem, saying that dozens of their election agents were denied letter of recommendation to the lowest tier of governance jurisdiction, which stopped the political campaign coordinator from accessing voting booth around the country. The same complication also, impacted CHADEMA at Arusha, Mbeya including Mwanza, among many other. Whereas, in Singida, CHADEMA was managed to obtain a brief note of introduction for its vice-chairperson Mr. Tundu Lissu who handled out the brief note of introduction to them in evening 26/11/2025.

3.2.2. Electoral Fraud

CHADEMA including ACT-Wazalendo noted electoral fraud episodes in several areas around the country. ACT-Wazalendo, in particular, contended to have detained a candidate at Mwandiga, Kigoma region, who held forged ballots that he intended to send to a voting booth. Moreover, the party declared to face obstacles in Nyamale including Nkome located in Geita, where many people were detained with electoral fraud. CHADEMA's leaders also seized six boxes of forged ballots in Nyantimba polling booth in Nyaruntembo located Chato, Geita region. In addition, CHADEMA proclaimed to seize forged ballots in Bariadi located Shinyanga, as well Msalala in Morogoro, including Kibaha specifically (Tangini, Pangani and Msangani wards) in Pwani, Igunga located Tabora, and two wards in Segerea (Kisukuru, Kuhanga) as well Ukonga (Chanika Street) at Dar es Salaam region. One of the witnesses who had involved in Tanzania's politics for more than 20 years painfully complained:

What kind of rigging is this? The result cannot be considered credible.... the election was completely illegitimate. The will of the people cannot be stolen by force. The results must be annulled, and the election redone transparently and fairly.

Then the Chama cha Mapinduzi (CCM) won 99% of chairperson in local government elections, CHADEMA 0.7% and The Alliance for Change and Transparency (ACT-Wazalendo) scored 0.07%. The opposition parties conclude that the election was ridiculed as well uncredible. In fact, there was no election but just a charade. International Peace Institute (2011) revealed that in certain circumstance, elections are maneuvered to legitimate absolute regimes or to ascertain hereditary rule on some part of Africa. Illegal interference with the process of an election is a notable attribute of election in Tanzania. In many occasions maneuver is aimed to keep incumbents in power. The ruling party (incumbent) utilize their control over the finite automaton to decide election returns. Norris (2012) revealed similar return to the outcome obtained that, electoral bodies are planned in accordance to support cheating by rejecting credible election (Norris, 2012).

3.2.3. Political Violence

In spite of, Tanzania holding more 12 regular elections for five-years periodically, the civilization of free and credible elections continues unarticulated in the county (Mwanga, 2022). As the polling stations in the local government elections closes, the country for a second time witnesses outrageous lie as well scandalous behavior by state machinery acting together to audaciously manipulate election in favor of CCM and its nominees, even at the expense of Tanzanian.

CHADEMA claimed that almost three episodes of rumored murder of dissent with their official's party as well nominees, as a case of George Juma Mohamed, the party's nominee for local election in Mkwese ward, Manyoni district, Singida region was shot dead inside his residence, as Tanzania police dispersed fellow villages to prevent election fraud. CHADEMA as well noted rumored murder belong to its officials in Tunduma located in Songwe region, Mr. Steven Chalamila, who was reportedly assaulted by an anonymous assailant at his residence, resulting in his demise. He was brutally attacked and hacked to death. The party, also recorded the rumored murder of Modestus G. Timbisimilwa, its aspiring candidate in Ulangoni A street, Gongolamoto, Dar es Salaam, who reportedly died while being harmed by law enforcement agents. Timbisimilwa was claimed to be blocking of forged ballots at a polling booth. He was shot and killed by police while attempting to prevent the smuggle in of fraudulent votes at a polling station. Burchard (2015) assert that in Africa there is not the slightest election hold on without an isolated event of violence (Burchard, 2015). Once, principal author of the American Declaration of Independence, Thomas Jefferson, remarked:

"The fundamental nature as well pleasure, and not their demotion is at the top and solely authentic object of responsible leadership".

Other challenges that raised during the local government election was police brutality of political party leaders as well aspiring candidates, for instance ACT-Wazalendo reported that police detained two of its party leaders in Tunduru including Pangani located Tanga, where other party officials were detained. One respondent lamented that:

A party that boasts of being loved and bringing development but relies on rigging elections, disrupting the process, and using threats of abduction and even killing people is a huge disgrace to our nation. Genuine love from the people doesn't require force.

Such situation confirm 2024 local election like those of 2019 and 2010 elections was not credible election by any measure.

3.3. Credibility of Local Election 2024

Credibility as well fair elections are important aspect for constitution government. The local government election as it was in 2019 and now 2024 lacked the values that demonstrate the fair and credibility of democratic elections. The electoral procedures weekend electoral credibility, for instance the personal who represented the cabinet minister of republic in the Presidents' Office, Regional Administration and Local Government (PO-RALG) demonstrated open bias towards the ruling party candidates in interpreting the law. The electoral personal disqualified the hundreds of opposition candidates on the ground that they didn't meet the legal baseline.

On July 15th, 2024 the former Tanzania ICT Minister Nape Nnauye on the spot for claimed that the election returns are not decided by numbers based on voters in the polling booth, however, rely on who records and reports the outcomes. This was confirmed in the local election 2024, as it happens in 2019 local election as well 2020 general election which lacked any aspect of being free, fair and credible election. In the video, Mr. Nnauye asserted that other people expecting to vie for leadership, should hold off since there was no worries for them stay waiting. Also, Mr. Nnape continue to say in the video clip:

"Since I am better at electioneering tactics, I will help you to win. Election outcomes are not compulsory those in the basket, more precisely they rely on the person calculate and make calculation. There are multiple tricks exist; legal, half legal as well illegal. All the three were available for use, thereafter you ask forgiveness from GOD".

Such statement pose questions to the current regime, where is quotability and commitments to democracy including principles of effective management? So, the government is droving the country away from rule of law, good governance, democracy as well human rights. And this has always been the case for long time, Nnape just exposed what has been the true practice in the country. The parties participated in the local election such as ACT-Wazalendo, CUF and CHADEMA alleged that the local elections were not free and fair.

On top of that, on December 4, 2024 a highly respected former Prime Minister and Vice President Judge Joseph Side Warioba commented that the local election 2024 was not credible since it involved fake votes and some dissidents were killed. In connection to that the authority treats it's dissident as a subhuman group, unworthy of human rights as well dignity, demonstrating its specific intent of not respecting international Convention Against Torture (CAT) which aims to prevent torturing. However, since the adaption of multi-party systems in 1992, Tanzania has failed to nurture credible democratic institutional framework. But elections have continued to be a relief-valve to support tyranny authority. An attempt to end tyranny regimes has proved failure. Elections has lost its legitimacy. Demonstrable lack of credible election, accelerated democratic regression in the country, since "... election is but also the rule of the people, they likewise the demise about tyranny (Huntington, 1991).

3.4. Abduction and Harassment of Dissidents

The latest trend of kidnapping, detention as well savage murder of an opposition party leader in Tanzania appears to be fading the beacon of political hope that emerged with President Samia Suluhu Hassan's ascend to power 2021. There was a massive sense of ease when Hassan-Tanzania's first woman President-took organize political meetings including speak out against the government fearlessly of negative consequences. Nevertheless, there's a rising sense of alarm that Tanzania is reverting to the reign of her tyrannical precursor, Dr. John Pombe Magufuli. The political environment in Tanzania is alarming in the intense situation (Tanzania Election Watch, 2021). Currently, Tanzania is witnessing an influx of much oppression as well state engineered violence which was more typical between 2016 to 2020, during the reign of Dr. Magufuli. Recently, there has been some abduction events, the following are some of incidences:

On September 8, 2024, Mr. Ali Mohamed Kibao, an elder statesman member of the leading opposition party Chadema, he was discovered deceased after being abducted by two gunmen coerced him off a bus going ahead from Dar-es-Salaam to Tanga city. His corpse was later discovered on the outskirts of Dar-es-Salaam with signs of brutal beatings as well flooded with acid. This episode shocked the country. Due to assassination of Ali Mohamed Kibao the U.S Embassy to Tanzania issued statement:

The United State become part of who calls for a self-sustained, translucent, as well swift inquiry into perpetual kidnapping including the assassination of Mr. Ali Mohamed Kibao, assassination and dissolution as well recent confinement, brutality, and other exertion to disqualifying people prior to the general elections, should not be tolerated in a democratic country. These brutal acts undermine rights guaranteed by the Tanzanian constitution. We extend our deepest condolences to the family of Mr. Kibao and country for the loss of his life and civic leadership.

On November 18, 2024 Also the Catholic bishops in Tanzania (TEC) through their Deputy President as well Bishop of the Catholic Diocese of Mpanda, Eusebius Alfred Nzigilwa, declaimed, the bishops' affirmation concerning the latest abduction as well the killing in Tanzania. Tanzania Episcopal Conference strongly condemned the incidents:

Tanzania has mostly recognized as a place of quietude... stop the killing together with abductions.

In respect with what is going on matter concerning political rights, Tanzania remains a dangerous country in which to be a member of the political opposition, despite adoption of multi-party system since 1992 and a change of president in 2021. In responding of current situation, one respondent painfully commented:

In Tanzania the legal regulation does not act accordingly. Government's dissenters are frequently kidnaped, tortured, detained as well assassinated...How free are we? Can we real criticize our government without being harassed?

On Jun 27, 2024 Edgar Mwakalabela a young entrepreneur who is also an outspoken critic of the government. He was kept at Oyster Bay (upmarket) police station in Dar es Salaam hidden and unregistered. He was later driven from Dar to Arusha then to Katavi. He was severely tortured and beaten all throughout before he was left in Katavi National Park to die. Again, on October 19, 2024 Abduction of CHADEMA senior member, Aisha Machano, women's group press officer, was kidnapped in Kibiti town via eastern part of Tanzania whereas she was carrying out officials' responsibilities. Unidentified people abducted, beaten, stripped, and seriously injured, before dumping her in remote area and warned to stay silent. Machano was the second superior opposition leader to be kidnapped as well tortured within couple months ago. She was tortured and beaten by state affiliated goons who wanted to know who instructed them (CHADEMA-women) to burn their cloth (Kitenge) with President Samia Suruhu Hassan's picture that they wore in 2023. After, she was rushed into emergency surgery. One commentator had this to say:

The current situation in Tanzania for people who support opposition is very bad...these are tell signs of what to expect in 2025 general election...the authority is a brutal petty dictator...Tanzania is turning fascist country.

Currently, political right and human rights is at stake. We are insisting that the country should stick around the basic unit of protecting as well preventing violence of civil liberties. Human rights should be placed at the Centre of everything we do.

Since 18th August 2024, up to date (1/4/2024) Deusdedith Soka with two young men are still missing. He is an activist as well upcoming political leader. Deusdedith Soka and Jacob Godwin Mlay, both Chadema youth activists, and Frank Mbise, a motorcycle taxi driver, were abducted by a group of men suspected to be police officers on 18 August. In July 2024 Shadrack Chaula an artist drew the picture of Samia Suluhu Hassan and burnt it. He was arrested, charged and jailed within 24 hours a record. Then, people organized themselves paid his fine and got him out with a week. Later, in August 2024, Chaula was taken by a government issued vehicle and plain clothes men who said they were from the Regional Commissioner's Office. Chaula has not been seen since. This is what is happening to dissent of government. One respondent painful lamented:

It is painful to witness these abductions happening so frequently. As we move closer to the 2025 general election, the fear of these incidents escalating grows stronger. This isn't a passing worry; it is a serious call for awareness and action. Let's stand together for safer future.

On December 1, 2024 an opposition youth leader of ACT-Wazalendo party Abdul Nondo was abducted by unknown assailants from bus station in the principal city, Dar es Salaam, taken by two people traveling in a white color four-wheel motor vehicle. Later, Nondo was found tonight after being abandon on shore, within one day after he was allegedly abducted in the main city of Dar es Salaam. His party, said that, he was left behind at the shore by his kidnappers and severely beaten with injured and appealed aid from a motorcycle taxi operator, in that case took him to the party office. And later was taken to hospital. The situation is worrisome, the opposition politician and human activists are veiled as well perpetually assaulted whereas being intimidated with death penalty.

On January 12, 2025 a Tanzania's foremost and fearless human rights activist and critics of the current regime, Ms. Maria Sarungi was snatched by three unidentified gunmen in the vicinity of Yaya center in the Kenyan capital of Nairobi. Some people viewed Maria's abduction in Nairobi with her legitimate criticism against current regime ([Amnesty International-Kenya, 2025](#)). She was released hours after the incident. Shortly, after the Maria's abduction, one commentator had this to present:

If there is any issue, it must be addressed based on the law and the constitution, while respecting the laws and international human rights treaties.

The situation in Tanzania is deeply concerning and not getting nearly the attention it deserves, despite the current regime emphasizing on the 4Rs, reconciliation, resilience, reforms, and rebuilding, yet the reality tells a darker story. Citizens are abducted by unknown people without due process, tortured, held incommunicado, and denied legal representation. Opposition politicians are barred from elections on flimsy excuses. Hypocrisy on full display.

3.5. Freedom of Speech

According to Article 19, of the framework of human rights treaties established after, 1948, each person is entitled to express their views; this precise involves freedom of thought without further intervention together with seeking, receive as well sharing information and thoughts via my media and irrespective of boundaries.

3.5.1. Abuse of Freedom of Speech

On August 2023, Dr. Wilibrod Slaa, among of the annotator of Tanzania's government, he was in detained at his residence in Dar es Salaam. He was dismissed in a couple of days in conversation with the police, he was apprehended for inciting. Yet, the government invalidated the statement that Dr. Slaa's arrested more two more (Boniface Mwabukusi and Mpaluka Nyangali). More specifically were detained in the course of the police for making public threats of a serious fraudulent nature, which involved calling for the coercive power grab of the day. Again, Dr. Slaa is illegally detained since January 10, 2025 when police arrested him at midnight in his home. He was denied bail for a bailable offense and not released to date (20/2/2025). He was charged with publishing false information on social media after he claimed in a public conversation that the authority bribed Freeman Mbowe to remain in leadership of his party CHADEMA, since Mbowe is considered to be lenient politician compared to Tundu Antiphas Lissu who seem to be tenacious politician. A continued unlawful detention, cruel, torture and inhumane treatment of Dr. Slaa must be condemned by all freedom lovers across the globe. He is an elderly person who shouldn't be abused like this.

3.5.2. Suspension of Citizen Magazine

On October 2, 2024-the Tanzania Communication Regulatory Authority (TCRA) suspended the online publishing of the Citizens Mwananchi News for posting an animation about abductions, torturing and killings of people critical of the nation's leader for 30 days. Tanganyika law society lists 83 people seized since 2016. The communication authority citing the publication of prohibited content that violated the computerized with post communication Regulations, 2020. The regulatory said that the advert published was:

Threatening and potential damaging national solidarity as well tranquility with society of the state.

The suspended services were based on the citizen mwananchi digital, mwananch and mwananch sport. This was purely intimidated. Some commenters painfully lament. One respondent who had experience of Tanzania politics said:

It seems we are back in business as usual; all past laws now have been fully activated. Many hard and painful years to come.

While, another commenter argued "suppression of free speech is contentious", Based on the available circumstances, one commentator said:

The current regime's is taking a country into a dictatorship where those who are going against here leadership are kidnapped and killed. The regime's now avoid being exposed by threatening freedom of speech by suspending media houses.

In the other hand, the Biden-Harris Administration was quick to embrace the current regime and believed they would democratize Tanzania. However, the administration has failed to confront the reality of the ruling party's repressive reflexes, as it has shown it continues to prioritize its own survival over democracy. One remarkable respondent who were interested in what is going on argued:

The current regime has been an authoritarian government. People are kidnapped, tortured, killed, and their bodies thrown like garbage and no action is taken. There is a great fear that the government itself is running this criminal gang.

Moreover, another respondent had this to say:

The situation is dire on the ground than what is observable on live. Tanzania is slipping into a tyrannical state, as government is right there aiding.

Geneva, on October 17, 2024 United Nations- Human rights called for urgent action amid crackdown on civil society ahead local government and general elections 2025. The UN human rights experts called on escalating pattern of human rights violations pattern of human rights violations against opposition political party members, civil society organizations, journalists, indigenous peoples and human rights defenders. In the lead-up to local elections in November 2024 and the presidential election in October 2025, voter registration and public rallies by opposition political parties marred by harassment and intimidation, arbitrary arrests, deprivation of liberty, enforced disappearances, torture, unlawful killings and restrictions on freedom of expression. The investigators claimed:

We are alarmed by rising incidents of abduction and escalating cases of human rights violations, including recorded killings of protesters and oppositions party members. We are concerned that this pattern of repression that this pattern of repression is aimed at suppressing political dissent and intimidating opposition to the government and will compromise the democratic and national electoral processes.

In line with this matter, the experts added:

“We also concerned about the reported restriction of the access to some social media platforms and the suspension of some media actors’ licenses in apparent retribution for disseminating a human rights advocacy video, and we urge the government to restore them immediately”.

It is important to defend inalienable rights online platform at a time of worsening intimidation. Once, Bob Marley said that you will never find justice in world where criminals make the law.

3.5.3. Attack of Guardian of Human Rights Defenders

Guardian of human rights defenders are in danger. Open attack on human rights lawyers by current regime. Mpale Mpoki is a well-known lawyer who has been for almost years part of numerous successful strategic litigation cases in old litigating successfully in the EACs repressive Media service law, fought to end death penalty, among others. On November 20, 2023 Mpoki was suspended for 6 months by a judge who took offense that Mpoki in his duty as defense attorney during a disciplinary hearing advised his client to reject him (the judge) for biasness. The lawyer facing disciplinary hearing was Boniface Mwabukusi who was leading charge in court and in the streets opposing the dodgy DP world deal. The judiciary is now threatening openly lawyers. What started with Fatma Karume, and many thought was an outlier case, now is becoming the norm. CCM is running openly authoritarian regime, now is continuing were Magufuli left off. They are using government institution to weaken their dissidents.

4. Conclusion

I don't ask the government either become saint or to love one another, but restructure this approach, that offer so many chances for hatred, torture, abduction and killing. Now let install a system which encourages and calls for solidarity. There is no reason why this political cancer should persist in presenting political illegitimacy to the enjoyment of greater dignity and political de jure by quite a lot of human species from now on, as they had done in the past election of 2019 and 2020, they have repeated in 2024. Despite the fact that, yet, a unanimous agreement that each one of two survivors of misery and oppression are entitled to more. Then, how do we get started?

No matter what frontal assault on democracy, it remains the best preferred system of government across the global. There is no option but to make it viable, taking the necessary steps, address governance deficits, ensuring democracy delivers the anticipated social goods. It's also essential to include civil society in the conversation as states seek to implement the recommendations of the resolution adopted today.

5. Recommendations

- An engaged as well vibrant civil community should be sustained to hold up a functioning democratic system, which can accomplish goals for all of its people.
- The community should be sensitized to stand shoulder to shoulder to defend their core values of democracy, freedom, human rights, political rights and integrity.
- Tanzania needs a new constitution in order to address the current challenges especial human rights as well political rights.
